

# SECTION 10: PERSONAL KIT LIST

Incoming Transmission from A.C.M.E. Headquarters...

Attention, Junior Field Agents!

Your participation in the **A.C.M.E. Spy Training Camp** has been confirmed.

To ensure mission success, every agent must arrive fully prepared and equipped for field operations.

Please report for duty with the following personal equipment and essential gear – inspected, labelled, and ready for deployment.

Each **Junior Field Agent** must **pack their own mission bag** to ensure they know exactly where every piece of their equipment is stored. All **mission equipment** must be packed in a **bag that your Junior Field Agent can carry independently** and access easily during operations. Large hiking backpacks are not recommended – they slow down quick gear retrieval during missions. A **zip-style duffle bag** makes the perfect undercover agent pack: simple, secure, and easy to open when the mission heats up!

**Junior Field Agents are to arrive in full cub uniform.**

**Top Tip from A.C.M.E.** *“Label every item clearly – even the best agents can’t solve the mystery of a missing sock!”*

The following items will not be allowed and will be removed on arrival:

1. Personal sweets, cold drinks or snacks of any sort. (There may be agents on camp with peanut allergy and cannot risk harm to any attendees).
2. Personal electronic devices – phones, tablets, computers or video games.
3. Knives (excluding eating knife).

Remember: a well-prepared agent is always one step ahead of V.I.L.E.!
